MQA GUIDELINES:

Colorado State Guidelines: A Meat Quality Assurance Program is required for all 4-H members enrolled in a market and/or breeding livestock project:

Once as a first year member who is a Junior or Intermediate member (between the ages of 8 and 13)

Again when a member becomes a Senior (age is 14 years old)

The only exception to being required to take it twice would be for a first time member who was 14 or older. In that case it would only be required once.

Those members not required to attend a MQA Program are encouraged to complete a Quality Assurance Checklist

To qualify for State Fair as a Swine exhibitor, Pork Quality Assurance must be taken the first three years and then again at age 15.
